General:

The Lord continues to grow and expand the teaching of His Word, making disciples, and supporting pastors in East Africa through *justBible Ministries*. The multiplication of pastors and teachers learning and being resourced continues as the Lord provides increasing opportunities. *Followship* is the branch of the ministry that holds Symposiums which teach the Word of God and make disciples. *Projects* provides physical structural support to vetted ministry partners who are committed to the discipleship mission.

The Board of Directors has increased providing great guidance to the ministry's activities. The Board consists of:

Finances:

In 2025, the Lord blessed *justBible Ministries* with total donations of \$62,721.34. Total funds distributed were \$66,516.42.

General administrative expenses were \$927.11 covering costs for items such as printing, mailing, website, and internet costs.

Followship and Projects funds that were distributed equaled \$65,589.31 to support our partners to teach the Word of God and improve ministry physical structures in Kenya and Uganda.

At the end of 2025, the ministry was blessed with a balance of \$11,079.48. As we look forward to 2026, the Lord has provided the resources to continue supporting our partners in teaching His Word and improving their ministry infrastructures.

As a 501(c)(3) registered organization, *justBible Ministries* values the necessity to be financially transparent to our donors and supporters. *justBible Ministries* does not employ anyone and there are no salaries paid by the ministry. All donations are distributed to the specific category that is



designated. Except for transaction fees (by financial institutions), 100% of designated donations go to the intended *Project* or activity. All general funds are covered by specific general fund donations or undesignated donations. Donated funds are distributed to the designated recipient; meaning that no portion of the *Project* designated donations are used to cover general administration costs or salaries other than necessary bank transaction fees. Funds that exceed the *Project* cost and undesignated donations are stewarded at *justBible Ministries*' discretion and control to support the most needed ministry activity.

Fellowship Activities:

International Symposium:

Seeta Nazigo, Uganda:

The ninth, three-day Symposium was held in July at Zion Community Center, in Seeta Nazigo, Uganda. A team of six people from the United States traveled to Uganda to participate in teaching at the Symposium. The entire book of Colossians was taught to international village pastors and teachers. Groups from Kenya, Uganda, Tanzania, Ethiopia, Congo, Burundi, South Sudan, and Rwanda attended this Symposium with the vision to utilize the resources they received and hold their own independent Symposiums in their local villages. Each participant in attendance received a workbook of Colossians in English, Lugandan, or Swahili. Bibles were also provided (Lugandan, Swahili or English) to those who had never owned one. *justBible Ministries* covered the cost for the travel of these international teams, materials, Bibles, one meal each day, sound system, chairs, and security. These Symposiums are free for the Africans to attend. As the Lord continues to provide opportunities and funds, *justBible Ministries* will make disciples without charge to those who are desperate and hungry for His Word!


Concurrently, the US team along with Ugandan counterparts, held a Children's Symposium. Two hundred fifty (250) children attended to learn the good news from Colossians.

The children learned the wordless gospel booklet and taught it to the adults. They also



attendees of the Symposium were provided a wordless gospel booklet to share Christ with their friends, neighbors, and community.

Virtual Pastor Training:



In April we initiated a live internet Bible Study Techniques workshop to 14 pastors in Nairobi, Kenya at Christian Restoration Church pastored by Pastor Maurice. This was a one-day training using the book of Malachi to teach Bible study methods providing the pastors knowledge on how the Symposium workbooks are structured so they can use them effectively as they go out and teach.

justBible Ministries purchased the equipment and materials to conduct this virtual training. Utilizing this equipment and capability will allow for additional training and continued expansion of disciple making.

Partner Symposiums:
The expansion of discipleship in East Africa:

Kenya:

Pastor Maurice Adum from Nairobi, Kenya has taken the teachings of 1 Peter to twelve (12), one per month, different locations throughout East Africa.

Pastor Maurice used the 1 Peter workbook that he received at the 2024 International Symposium in Uganda. *justBible Ministries* supported he and his wife as they traveled to multiple locations in Kenya, Uganda, Congo, Tanzania, South Sudan, and Burundi. At each location 200 workbooks (Swahili or English) were



provided to local pastors and teachers who attended these Partner Symposiums. *justBible Ministries* provided the funds for these workbooks to be printed in Kenya enabling Pastor Maurice to teach and resource rural village pastors to continue fulfilling the Lord's command to make disciples.



Uganda:

Pastor David from Seeta Nazigo, Uganda facilitated Partner Symposiums at seven different locations. Teaching these Partner Symposiums were pastors who previously attended the Bible Study Technique workshop. The book of James was taught to 300 attendees at these various locations.



Projects Activities:

Zion Community Center - Uganda:



This Community Center is where the annual Symposiums have been held for the past 12 years. In 2025 *justBible Ministries* continued construction on the Community Center by providing funds for completing the concrete floor, building a new toilet facility to support the increasing attendance of the Symposiums, and renovated the front housing building for out-of-country guests which included new bunk beds. The front building will be used to house teachers during the school year.



Volunteer Heart Community for Girl Child-Concern (VHC-GCC) – Uganda:

This organization reaches out to girls that have been compromised and provides them with an opportunity to learn vocational skills. The objective is to train girls who have been trafficked, abused, and/or orphaned with the credentials to work in their vocation and be self-sufficient. VHC-GCC provides housing for girls that do not have a safe place to live. VHC-GCC houses them or finds sponsor families to provide housing. Currently there are over 25 girls enrolled in the training programs.



VHC-GCC is in the process of constructing a dormitory to house girls that do not have a safe place to stay while they are training. The foundation, walls, and roof were completed in 2024. In 2025, the electrical system, plumbing and doors/windows frames were installed. *justBible Ministries* contributed the majority of the funds on the dormitory construction.



Seya Light School - Uganda:

We continue our monthly support of Seya Light School, a remote country village school with teaching that is Biblically based. This school is a very short distance from a government funded Muslim school which causes challenges of retaining students.

justBible Ministries funded the digging of a water well providing clean water for the school, church, and community.



Looking forward to 2026:

International Symposium – Nairobi, Kenya

The next International Symposium is scheduled for April 23-25, 2026, in Nairobi, Kenya. It will be held at Christian Restoration Church facilitated by Pastor Maurice. The targeted attendance is 400 pastors and teachers and 200 children. There are plans for 10 different countries to be represented. The book of James will be taught during these three days.

This Symposium is a result of God providing a significant opportunity to expand the teaching of His Word and disciple many who will in-turn disciples those they influence. Please join us in prayer for this event as follows:

1. We receive the appropriate amount of funds to print workbooks, purchase Bibles, provide meals, children's materials, and cover travel costs.
2. That the message of the book of James to walk a life for Christ is clearly presented and received.
3. Safe travel and good health during the trip.

Partner Symposiums:

Pastor Maurice has scheduled Partner Symposiums every month with the intent to teach the book of Colossians. The schedule and location of these Symposiums are as follows:

Zion Community Center – Uganda:

Since 2013, *justBible Ministries* has continually provided funds to complete this facility. This facility is where the Ugandan Symposiums are held. The remaining tasks to complete this building are installing a sound system, tiling the floors, and painting.

Volunteer Heart Community for Girl Child-Concern (VHC-GCC) – Uganda:

We will continue the construction of the girl's dormitory. Plans are in place to plaster the facility, tile the floor, paint, and install the door/window glass. Upon completion of these activities, the dormitory will have the capacity to house up to 40 girls. What a blessing it will be to provide security and comfort, showing the love of God to these girls.

Seya Light School – Uganda:

Plans are in place to continue construction on the Seya Light property by building classrooms for the older students. The remodeled classrooms in 2025 were for the younger children. In 2026, our mission is to initiate the building of classrooms to replace the current ones being used as shown in this picture.
